

Transporting a cake can be one of the most nerve racking things you can do.

I wouldn't advise picking up a cake that consists of multi tiers or lots of delicate decoration as they are easily broken or may require separate packaging and assembly on site.

If you choose to pick up your cake there are some things you will need to watch out for.

Firstly, make sure you have a flat surface to set the cakes on or a helpful volunteer to hold the cake while you travel. A slanted car seat is no place for a cake, the boot or floor is a safer option.

Use either a non slip mat or blanket to avoid the cake box/es from sliding around. You can also pack the empty space with other things like your handbag, shopping or any other stable item. But make sure it doesn't tower over the height of the boxes, as it may just fall on the cake.

Concentrating on the road can be enough of a challenge, extra care will need to be taken when you have cake! Carefully try to avoid pot holes, man hole covers, speed bump, sharp turns, sudden stops and fast acceleration. If in doubt; stop, check the cakes, re stabilize and continue on.
